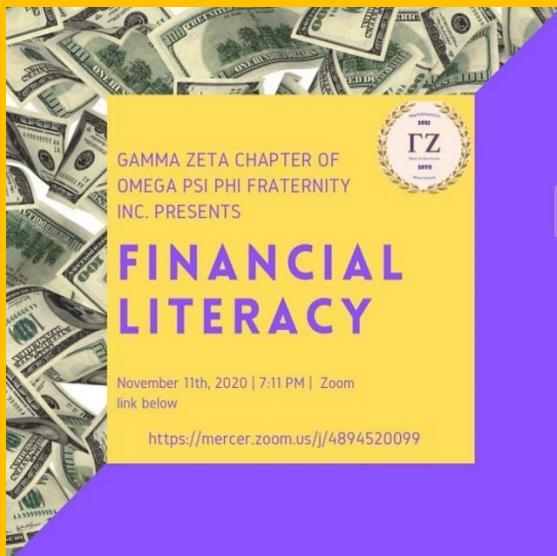

## HOW TO VOTE DURING THE 2020 U.S. ELECTION

View a list of upcoming elections and registration deadlines on the secretary of state's election calendar. Locate your polling place by logging into the secretary of state's [My Voter Page](#)

ON ELECTION DAY, POLLING STATIONS ARE OPEN FROM 7 AM - 7 PM.

IF YOU ARE UNABLE TO VOTE DURING THIS TIME, THEN YOU CAN EITHER VOTE EARLY OR SEND IN AN ABSENTEE BALLOT.

When you arrive at the polling station, you will need to have a valid **photo ID** such as a drivers license, passport, or voter identification card.

The polls offer audio ballots to voters who are blind or have low vision and booths for voters in wheelchairs. If you need help with your ballot, you can ask family members or friends to come with you and Assist in filling out the ballot with your choice

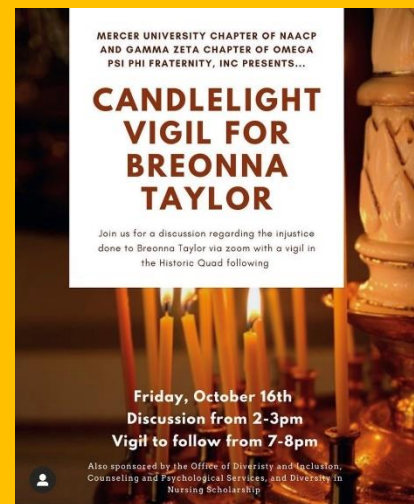
If you move, you must file a notice of your new address in writing to your [county board of registrars office](#) or submit a new voter registration application

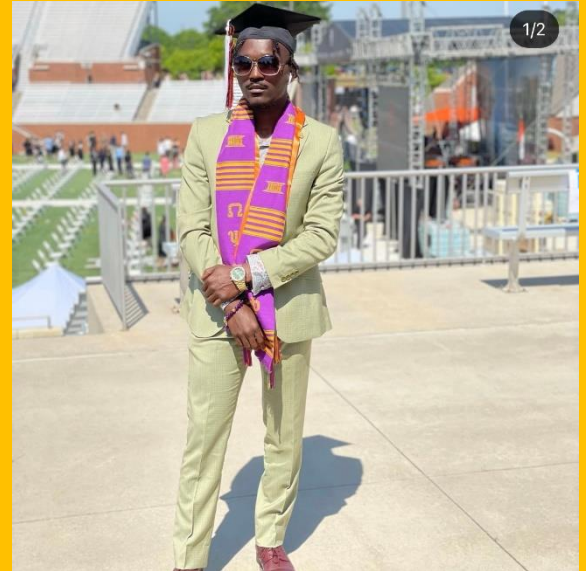
