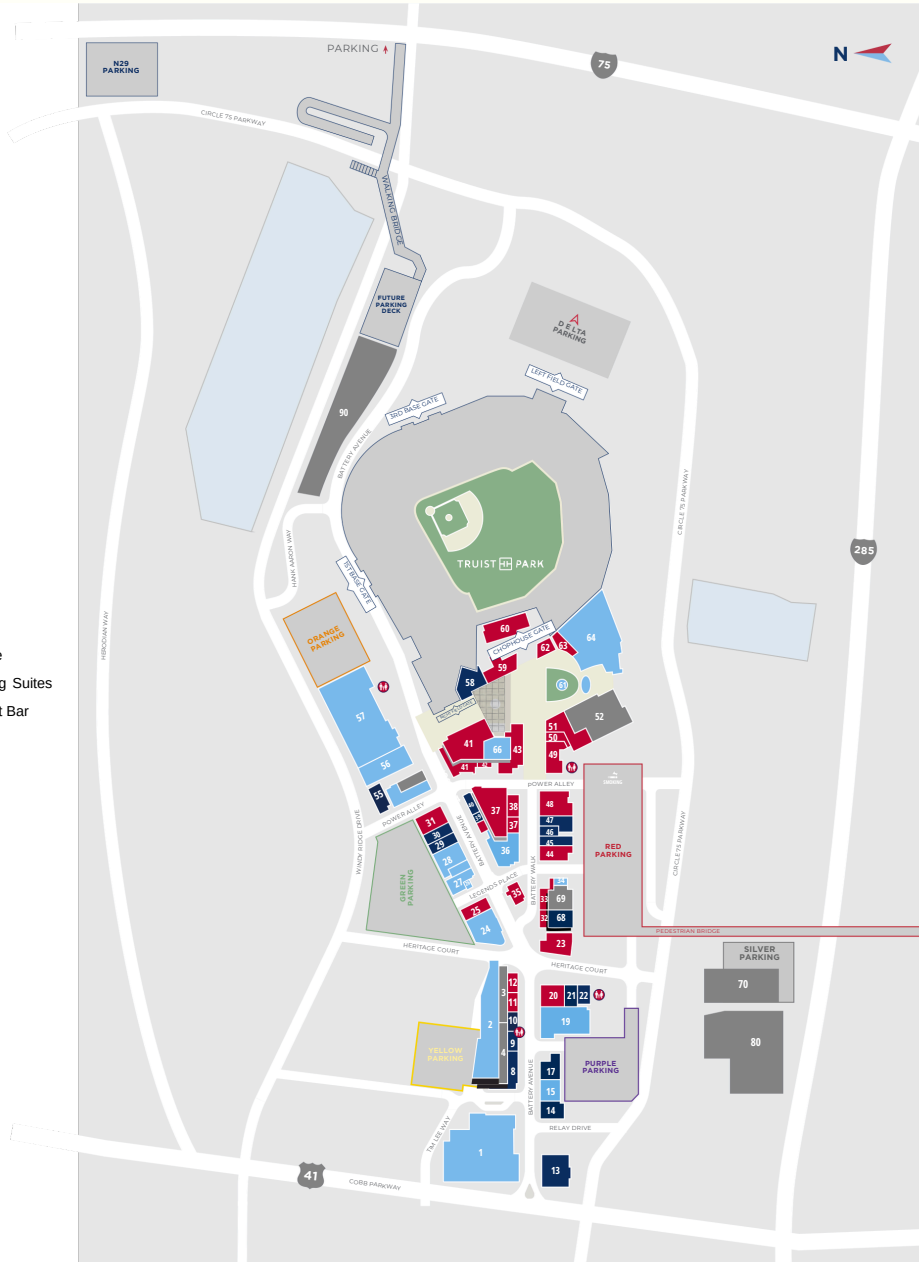
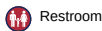

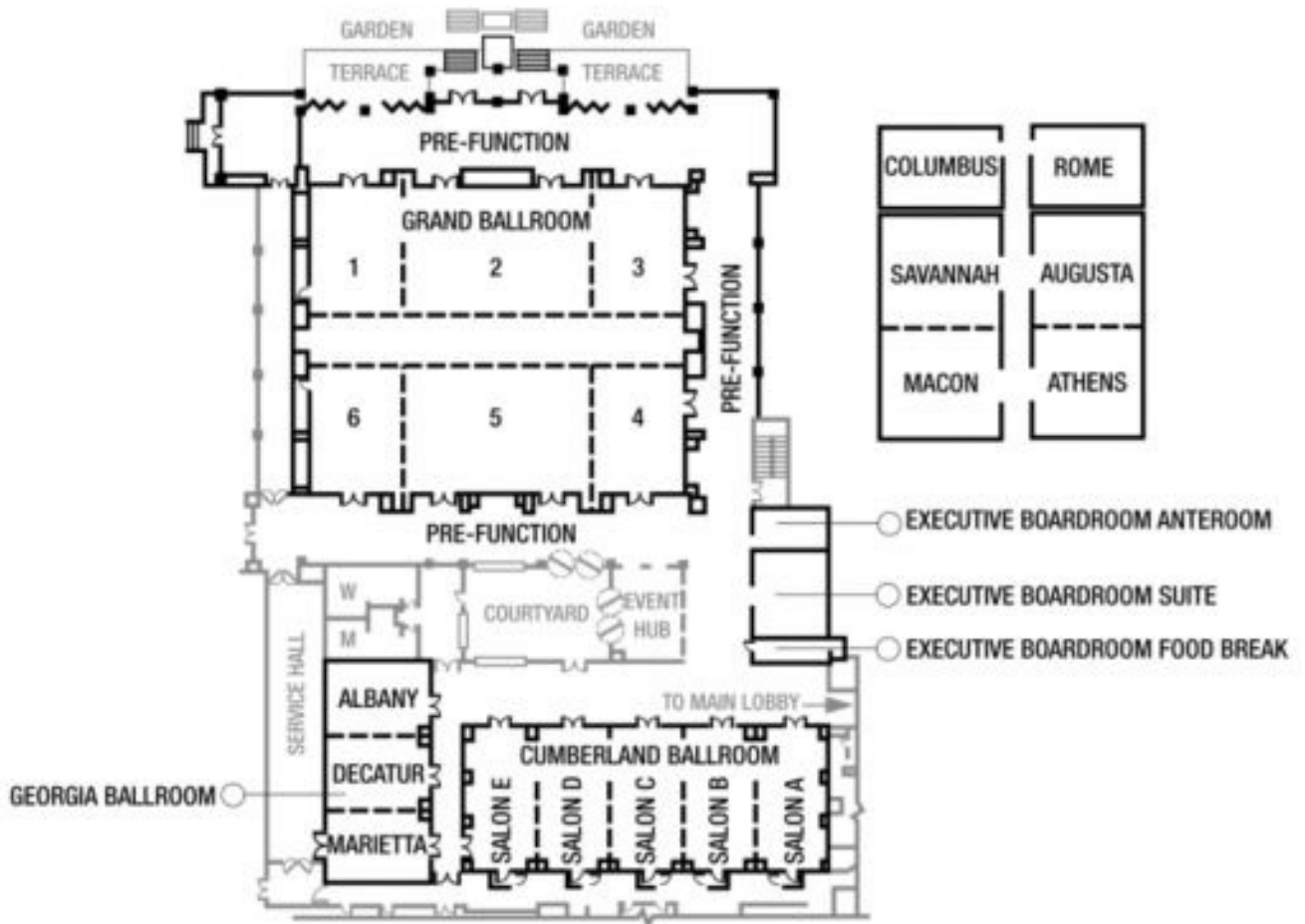

Times and logistics will be shared in advance with each approved vendor. Current Omega vendors are required to submit online a copy of their current license issued by Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc. along with payment.
